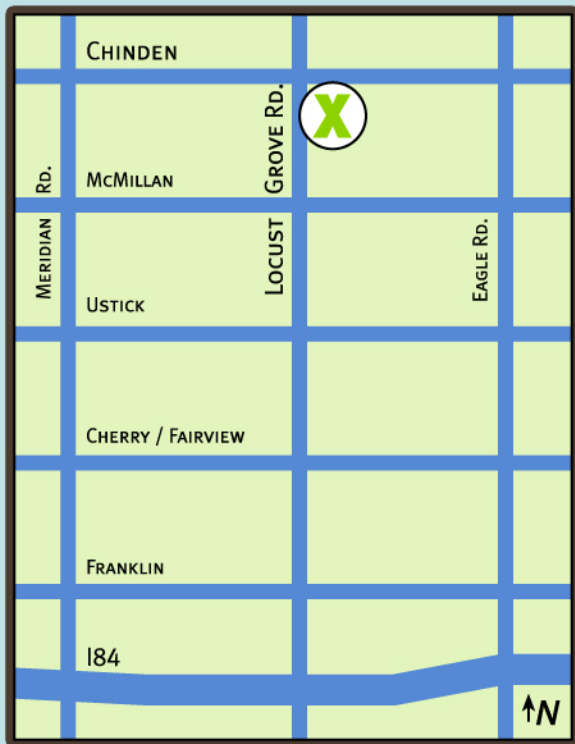

Raising children is one of those areas where the rubber meets the road for Christians. Is there anything we want more than to see our children grow up to love and trust both God and us?

Raising our children is equally important to God. He tells us He wants godly children (Malachi 2.15). He even calls our children His own, and that from birth (Ezekiel 16.20-21). Accordingly, God spends a lot of time in Scripture telling us and showing us how to raise our children so that they delight both Him and us.

But God is not the only one telling us how to raise our children—our culture is speaking to that issue constantly. And unfortunately, what God is telling us and what our culture is telling us are increasingly at odds. The temptations have never been greater for Christian parents to drift away from God's instruction and example.

The purpose of this conference is to call us back to God, to take a fresh look at His instruction and example, and to renew our commitment to raise godly children God's way.

Pastors Douglas Wilson and Alan Burrow get together a few times a year with some other pastors and Christians to play classic rock and blues (and they are pretty good, if we must say so ourselves). They call this assemblage The Jenny Geddes Band. Doug, Alan, and the Band will bring us a good selection of rock and blues, with a few testimonies sprinkled in along the way. DOUGLAS WILSON is pastor of Christ Church in Moscow, Idaho, as well as a senior fellow of theology at New St. Andrew's College, and a founding board member of Logos School. He is the author of numerous books on the Christian family and Christian education, including "Standing on the Promises," "Reforming Marriage," and "Recovering the Lost Tools of Learning." His debates with prominent British atheist Christopher Hitchens are the subject of the book, "Is Christianity Good for the World?", as well as the film, "Collision." After serving in the U.S. Navy submarine service, Douglas completed a B.A. and M.A. in philosophy and a B.A. in classical studies at the University of Idaho. Douglas and his wife Nancy have three children and a bunch of grandchildren.



ALAN BURROW is pastor of The King's Congregation in Meridian, Idaho, as well as an Adjunct Professor of Criminal Justice at Northwest Nazarene University. Alan has taught and preached extensively over the years on raising godly children, teaching wisdom to teens, Christian courtship, and marriage. Before entering the ministry in 2007, Alan served as an Assistant United States Attorney for twenty years, and prior to that as a JAG officer in the U.S. Army. He has a Juris Doctor from Florida State University School of Law and a B.A. in History from Millsaps College. Alan and his wife Janet have five children and two grandchildren.
